I just returned from Cabo in mid-August, and now it seems we are starting to pack for our return to Mexico on October 6th.

We have had a great summer here in Vancouver. The weather has been the best in years. The work here continues. It is good to refresh as Audrey Ann and Perry (daughter and son-in-law) do most of the organization and leading of Bible studies. Audrey and I help out as we can. Word On The Street meets every Saturday night with some 10 to 15 attending. Audrey is finishing a Bible study on the book of 2nd Peter this Thursday.

I am still sending Bible studies for the crew via the Internet to the 'Anchor For The Souls' church aboard the Norwegian Sun cruise ship. They left the Vancouver Alaska run this past weekend heading to the Mexican Riviera run. We hope to see them in Cabo this October. Two weeks ago we met with Charo, who first introduced us to the church on the ship. Some elders of the church also visited at our home. See pictures below. Charo now lives in Calgary. She flew out for the long weekend to meet with the crew aboard the ship (See bottom picture. She wanted to meet with the elders to share a testimony of

her problem while she was still working on the ship with them, and how God has wonderfully led her out of the situation.

I wish to let everyone know that Audrey and I are planning a cruise with the Norwegian Sun next April. The cruise leaves Miami on April 26th and finishes in London, England on May 10th. I would like to extend an invitation to all of you to join us. We would hold Bible studies with the passengers (about 1 hour) during the day, and join the crew at night for worship services below deck. Our meetings with passengers would be on "at sea" days only. The cruise at the present is about \$1075 USD including taxes and port charges. It will stop in Portugal, Spain, France, Belgium, Holland and end in England.
